Wildfire Transition Partnership Programs

Multi-facetted broken down to 4 primary activities:

- 1. Business Ambassador Program
- 2. Planning a Successful Succession Program (PASS)
- 3. Training & Education
- 4. Opportunity Forums to encourage innovations & opportunity awareness



Business Ambassador Program

- This program is currently being partially funded by generous grants from Northern Development Trust and Cariboo Beetle Action Coalition, Community Futures and Western Economic Diversification (WED).
- Business Ambassadors are meeting with business owners and not for profit organizations providing assistance as needed to aid business owner's effectively and efficiently accessing the applicable programs that are available.

PASS (Planning a Successful Succession)

- The PASS component of the project is an expansion of a pilot project that is being funded in part by the Rural Dividend Program, Western Economic Diversification (WED) and partnering Community Futures offices.
- PASS is designed to assist business owners including those affected by the wildfires, to prepare for a successful business succession. This will include:
 - Mentoring Planning Workbook Financial incentive of up to \$3,000



Training & Education

- Training needs for impacted organizations are diverse.
- Major focus of the program will utilize an approach that allows organizations to identify their specific training needs, and obtain support in meeting those needs in the most effective manner.



Opportunity Forums

- Communities are reaching out and asking for direction to identify NEW economic opportunities in the region.
- Opportunities that are identified that support and/or create businesses as we rebuild our communities
